

Reservoir Hill

Reservoir Hill is an outdoor treasure with two access points: one off of Hot Springs Blvd and one on Hwy 160, behind the East Side Market. Parking is available at each trailhead and at Dr. Mary Fisher Park.

Reservoir Hill offers an 18-basket disc golf course, plus hiking, mountain biking, snowshoeing, and cross country skiing on the many trails traversing the hill. A trip to the observation deck is rewarded with expansive views overlooking the Continental Divide and the Town of Pagosa Springs. Reservoir Hill allows visitors a quiet escape in downtown Pagosa.



Reservoir Hill is abundant with wildlife, including mule deer, black bear, tassel eared squirrels, owls, and a variety of birds. See if you can find the various wildlife wood carvings on the hill, including the owls on Tecolote loop. Reservoir Hill is home to the endangered Pagosa Skyrocket wildflower, which blooms roughly mid-May to early June on the Skyrocket Trail.
